



There Have Been Recent Robberies at Local Construction Sites



Steps construction workers can take to reduce robberies

- Be alert and aware of your surroundings
- Be cautious of anyone who makes you feel uneasy
- Keep a safe distance from strangers
- Speak to non-construction personnel in public area where you can be seen and heard
- Work in well lit areas
- Secure or lock work space so that no one can walk in on you unexpectedly
- Do not carry large amounts of cash
- If you work early or late hours, arrange to come and go at the same time as a co-worker
- Avoid parking far away from your work site
- Call the Oakland Police Department non-emergency number, (510) 777-3333, to report suspicious persons. The police want to hear from you, and you could prevent a crime! Provide as much information as possible, including the time you noticed the person, the clothing worn, the shoes worn, and the manner in which the person walked.
- For crimes in progress and other emergencies, dial 911. If using a cell phone, dial (510) 777-3211 to reach the Oakland Police Emergency
