An important part of the ongoing Terminal 1 Renovation program will be the construction of the new Mechanical Building (T1 MB) and the renovation of Building M104, which together will form the new Terminal 1 Central Utility Plant Project (T1CUP). The T1CUP has been designed and will be constructed using green building guidelines for high-performance heating, ventilation and air conditioning systems; reduced water use; environmentally responsible refrigerants; safe materials; and healthy indoor air quality.

- Upgrade of the fire alarm system and installation of new fire protection system

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Turner Training Program covers Seven Weeks of Construction Management Classes

The Turner School of Construction Management is a fourteen course; seven (7) week program offered by Turner across the country to M/W/ DBE firms at NO cost to the participants and is conveniently held three times a year.

Classes are offered two nights per week (Tuesday and Thursday) for three hours (6:00 - 9:00 PM). The course culminates with a graduation ceremony where each participant is presented a Certificate of Completion. Acceptance into the program is based on information listed in the application form and each program is limited to a maximum of fifty (depending on location) construction companies or industry related firms that have not participated in the past.

There are three sessions held each year – the first in Oakland (spring), the second in San Jose (summer) and the third in San Francisco (fall).
