Improvements include rough and fine grading; minor demolition; the installation of ADA compliant paving and sidewalks; tree and landscape planting; connection to existing irrigation systems; installation of picnic tables, preparation tables, barbeque pits, site furniture, and other decorative hardscape elements; and other such items or details required by the Plans, Standard Specifications, and Special Provisions.
