- 2) Grant information is due Thursday, June 25, 2015, by 5:00 p.m. (No Exceptions)
- 3) Recipient(s) will be notified July 31, 2015
- 4) Money will be provided by January 29, 2016
- 5) All applicants must be in Alameda and/or Contra Costa County
- 6) Applicant program must be involved in educating within the architectural, engineering, planning, environmental and/or construction disciplines
- 7) Grant recipient(s) will be available to participate in at least ONE meeting prior to award, generally at the October, 2015 event
- 8) Grant recipient(s) must be available for formal presentation at BOC meeting January 28, 2016

4. Recipient must be educational.
5. Recipient must be located within Alameda or Contra Costa County.
