Day 1 Depart USA Depart on your overnight flight from the USA to China.

Day 2 Beijing Upon arrival at Beijing Airport you will be met by your Central Holidays tour director and be transferred to your hotel. Welcome to China's capital city, a lively mix of neighborhoods and districts and home of ancient treasures such as the Forbidden City and the Summer Palace. The Peoples' Republic of China beckons with a storied history dating back more than 5,000 years revealed in its imperial antiquities and rich culture for you to experience.

Day 3 Beijing After breakfast at your hotel, a full-day tour to explore Beijing awaits. From Tiananmen Square or "Gate of heavenly peace," and the Forbidden City, the imperial palace during the Ming and Qing Dynasties; to the Temple of Heaven, where Dynasties held sacred rituals; and on to the Olympic Village, built for the 2008 Summer Olympics - you will have the opportunity to delve into the past and present of this fascinating city. In the evening, savor an authentic Peking Duck Dinner for a delicious end to your day. (B,L,D)

Day 4 Beijing Start the morning with breakfast at your hotel and then embark on a sightseeing adventure to one of the world's ancient wonders, The Great Wall of China. Extending about 5,500 miles today, the first sections of the wall were built by the Qin Dynasty starting in about 220 BC to keep nomads and invaders out of China. Over the next thousand years sections were added, yet the more modern sections measuring up to 25 feet were constructed starting in 1388 by the Ming Dynasty and feature 71 passageways, 827 platforms and countless towers. Lecture on modern Chinese building techniques. (B,L)

Day 5 Beijing – Optional Tour to the Lama Temple, the famous Pandas and the Summer Palace The day begins with breakfast at your hotel then the choices are yours for the taking! Today you have the full day at leisure to explore Beijing or to enjoy an optional tour to explore the city's amazing history and culture on this tour to experience the Lama Temple (built in 1694 during the Qing Dynasty as the residence of the Emperor Yongzheng) the third emperor of the Qing Dynasty, the famous Pandas at the zoo, and the historic Summer Palace, said to be the best preserved imperial garden in the world, and the largest of its kind still in existence in China. First constructed in 1750, largely destroyed in the war of 1860 and restored in 1886 - is a masterpiece of Chinese

landscape garden design. The natural landscape of hills and open water is combined with features such as pavilions, halls, palaces, temples and bridges to form a pleasant collective of outstanding visual value. (B)

Day 6 Beijing/Xian - Optional Tour to the Big Wild Goose Pagoda, the City Wall and the Banpo Village Museum Rise and shine with breakfast at your hotel. This morning you will embark on a flight to Xi'an. Welcome to Xi'an the capital of China's central Shaanxi province and a must for history buffs. Once the gateway to the Silk Road and a meeting point for scholars, poets and monks, and today is home to timeworn artifacts from another world. In the afternoon you have the opportunity to partake in an optional tour of the Big Wild Goose Pagoda, the city wall and the Banpo Museum. At the Banpo Village Museum, your stop will take you 6,000 years in the past. We will tour the village and learn about the matriarchal community of the Yangshao culture through the various relics and exhibitions offered. An exciting evening of entertainment and fun follow with an included Tang Style Dancing Show. (B,D)

Day 7 Xian Power-up with breakfast at your hotel and then board your first-class motorcoach for an excursion to see the acclaimed Terra-Cotta Warriors at the Tomb of the First Emperor of Qin Dynasty. In 1974 discovery of thousands of life-sized Terracotta Warriors was one of the greatest archeological finds of the 20th century. These figures date back to 210 BC and were meant to guard the first emperor of China in the afterlife. See the huge statue of the emperor now guards the entrance to the Terracotta Warriors and Horses Museum, undeniable high point of any trip to Xian and the three enormous pits are filled with row upon row of these remarkable effigies, with the first pit alone holding some 6,000 examples in excellent condition. On route, a visit to the Xian Art Ceramic & Terra Cotta Factory gives you time to shop for artistic mementos to share your time in China. (B,L)

Day 8 Xian/Shanghai After breakfast, fly to Shanghai and transfer to your hotel. In 1841, the city was a small fishing village, but today it has transformed into the most westernized city in China and is at the forefront of China's modernization. The city is changing fast and nearly a quarter of the world's construction cranes are working in this city. This afternoon a panoramic city tour welcomes you to the vibrant sights and sounds of Shanghai. Often referred to as the "Pearl of China" or the "Paris of the Orient," your tour takes you to explore the essence of Shanghai visiting sites including the Bund located on the city's waterfront. The Bund is Shanghai's most famous attraction that ties together the city's old world and new, showcasing pre-1949 architecture in a row of buildings that served as its financial and commercial center in the 1930's. Lecture on modern Chinese architectural designs. (B,L)



Day 9 Shanghai to USA or extend your stay with an optional Shanghai extension Enjoy breakfast at your hotel before your transfer to the airport for your flight home or opt to stay an extra few days to explore even more of China's allure. (B)

OPTIONAL SHANGHAI EXTENSION

Day 9 Shanghai Today you will head out on a full-day tour to Suzhou, nicknamed "Venice of the East." Famous around the world for its methodically landscaped classical gardens and interweaving waterways. We visit the Master of the Nets Garden, Humble Administrator's Garden, and take a canal cruise with lunch included to round-out your experience. Afterwards return to your hotel in Shanghai. (B,L)

Day 10 Shanghai Have a hearty breakfast and get ready to live the magic of Shanghai with a full day at leisure. Explore the city at your own pace or join in an optional excursion to the Shanghai Museum or to the Jade Buddha Temple & Yu Garden (B)

Day 11 Shanghai to USA After breakfast today your transfer awaits to take you to the airport for your flight home. (B)
